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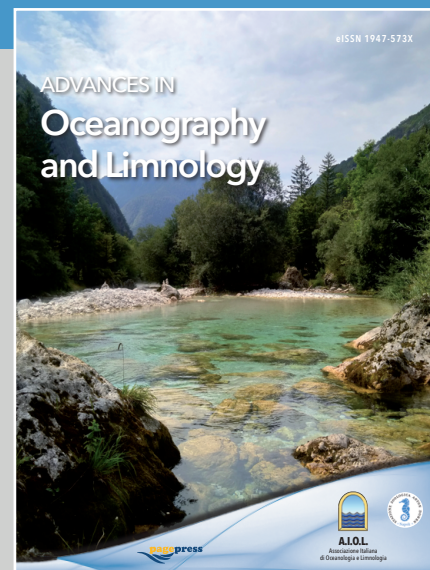

Particularly welcomed are studies focusing on marine and freshwater ecosystems.



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
