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Abstract

Recently, both Clarivate and Scopus announced improved metrics for the European Journal of Translational Myology (EJTM), bringing its Impact Factor to 2.0 and its CiteScore to 4.1. I am proud of these achievements and share the credit with the entire PAGEPress staff. Furthermore, many organizers and moderators for the “Padua Days on Muscle and Mobility Medicine” 2027 (2027 Pd3m) have accepted their roles and proposed improvements for the event, which will take place at the Euganean Thermal Baths (Padua, Italy) from March 9 to 12, 2027. The program remains open to numerous additional speakers. On the downside, rising operating costs are affecting both digital publishing and event organization; it is hoped that these increases will not negatively impact the submission of contributions to the EJTM and the 2027 Pd3m conference. Undoubtedly, the 2027 Pd3m promises to be an engaging event, on par with all previous editions of the “Padua Days on Muscle and Mobility Medicine.”

Recently, both Clarivate and Scopus announced an increase in metrics for the European Journal of Translational Myology (EJTM), bringing the Impact Factor to 2.0 and the CiteScore to 4.1. As editor-in-chief of the journal, I am proud of these results, but I must share the credit with the entire staff and with the founder and owner of PAGEpress, whose suggestions and decisions have been fundamental, given his generous investment in the EJTM over many years. I am also pleased to announce that many of the invited organizers and moderators - whose names appeared in the preliminary confidential brochure for the 2027 «Padua Days on Muscle and Mobility Medicine» (2027 Pd3m) conference— have accepted the role and proposed improvements to the selected topics, which will be discussed at the Euganean Thermae (Padua, Italy) from March 9 to 12, 2027. The 2027 program will include some new topics, including the new “Masterclass II on muscle rehabilitation in dysphagia and speech therapy,” scheduled for March 12, 2027. However, the program remains open to numerous speakers, as there are still many presentations to be announced. It is hoped that the call for oral

presentations will be met with a strong response from young speakers. And what about the downsides? Due to rising overhead costs - affecting both digital publication and event organization - fees for EJTM authors and 2027 Pd3m speakers will change. We trust that these increases will not negatively impact on the submission of contributions to the EJTM or active participation in the 2027 Pd3m. In any case, the 2027 Pd3m organizers have maintained the traditional registration fee waiver for young participants!
